Prop 18 expands voting rights to some 17-yearolds in California. Citizens who are 17 and are residents of the state will be allowed to vote in primary or special elections if they will be 18 before the related general election in November.





## SOIFYOU... VOTEYES?

A "yes" vote supports allowing 17-year old citizens and state residents to vote in primary and special elections as long as they will turn 18 by the subsequent general election.





## SOFYOU... VOTENOTE

A "no" vote supports maintaining the voting age at 18 for all state elections.
